The health and safety of our participants and volunteers is our highest priority. Here is what we're doing to keep you safe

Robust Safety Plan – We have worked closely with local health officials to develop a Safety Plan that meets, and in many areas exceeds, current guidelines. This comprehensive plan includes rink-wide sanitization protocols, social distancing measures, extensive COVID 19 transmission mitigation measures, and continuous oversight to ensure that the plan is being successfully followed.

Health and Safety Officers – These specially trained staff members will always be on duty during rink operations. They'll be trained in CDC, State, and local health department guidelines for proper sanitation methods, transmission mitigation methods, and management of safe gatherings. They will conduct health screenings of each staff member as they arrive for work, and continuously monitor all areas of the Village to ensure that established protocols are followed.

Reserved Sessions and Dynamic Pricing – This year we'll have scheduled skate sessions with online reservation and contactless payment available. We've also simplified our pricing system to encourage skaters to come at less busy times. Skate session prices will be the same for all ages, with the most affordable prices for morning sessions, mid-level pricing on weekday afternoons/evenings, and premium pricing on the weekends.

Equipment -- Skates and other equipment will undergo a thorough sanitization process by trained staff during and between sessions. Rink staff will perform and log routine sanitization of high touch areas throughout the rink. All staff will be trained in the sanitization measures required for their jobs.

Participant Safety – Everyone who enters the Winter Ice Village will be required to wear a cloth face covering. Participants in the designated skate area beneath the tent will not exceed 50 people. Advance, online, contactless skate session purchases will be available and encouraged.

Cocoa Shack – Our snack shack will follow current local and state requirements for restaurant operations. Staff members will be trained in these requirements, and social distancing will be strictly enforced for snack shack customers.

Personal Sanitization – Hand sanitizer will be widely available throughout the rink, and a hand washing station will be available near the portable toilets. The number of toilets on site will likely eliminate the need to wait in line.
